Dear neighbors,

Plan ahead for weekend closures of SR 520 and major changes coming to the Eastside! Please see below for information about the work, what you can expect and ways to stay informed about the project.

Project update: Northbound Bellevue Way left-turn lane access to westbound SR 520 is now open!

Note: Major weekend activities throughout the Eastside Project in June

1. Reminder - 84th Avenue Northeast roundabout construction staging and traffic impacts begin Monday, June 2

Phase 1 – June 2-6: We are nearly complete with this phase!

Beginning early the morning of Monday, June 2, crews completely closed Northeast 28th Street between 84th Avenue Northeast and Hawthorn Court for five days to build and pave the Northeast 28th Street leg of the roundabout. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists access Hunts Point and SR 520 via 84th Avenue Northeast.

Phase 2 – June 6-16: Beginning the night of Friday, June 6, crews will reopen Northeast 28th Street in a new configuration and then completely close the following to traffic:

- 84th Avenue Northeast between Hunts Point Circle and south of the Union 76 gas station
- 84th Avenue Northeast on-ramp to westbound SR 520
- Eastbound SR 520 off-ramp to 84th Avenue Northeast

This road and ramp closure will be in in place for ten days, until June 16, while crews build the on- and off-ramp legs to the roundabout, and demolish the old 84th Avenue Northeast roadway. Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists will access Hunts Point via Northeast 28th Street and the roundabout and SR 520 via 92nd Avenue Northeast and Bellevue Way.

Following Phase 2, crews will open the 84th Avenue Northeast roundabout in its final configuration by 5 a.m. on **Monday, June 16**. For more details of this work, check out the attached <u>fact sheet</u>.

 Weekend closure of SR 520 between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405 in Bellevue, June 6-9

Crews will close all lanes of SR 520 over the weekend of June 6-9 for many activities, including paving and restriping the westbound lanes. Crews will place the final lift of pavement on the westbound lanes. Crews will also complete critical work in other parts of the SR 520 corridor.

Details of the work:

- Date and time: 11 p.m. Friday, June 6 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 9
- Traffic and bus rider impacts: Crews will close all lanes of SR 520 and bus stops between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405 in Bellevue for the duration of the weekend. All ramps, roadways, and bus stops will reopen by 5 a.m. on Monday, June 9.

Crews to close Northup Way nightly between 108th Avenue northeast and Northeast 33rd Place, June 6-9

Over the weekend of June 6-9, crews will also close a portion of Northup Way at night between 108th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 33rd Place for noise wall panel installation. Crews will only work at this location during the night.

- Dates and times:
 - 11 p.m. Friday, June 6 to 7 a.m. Saturday, June 7
 - 9 p.m. Saturday, June 7 to 8:30 a.m. Sunday, June 8
 - 9 p.m. Sunday, June 8 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 9

1. Weekend closure of the intersection of Northup Way and 108th Avenue Northeast, June 13-

Over the weekend of June 13-16, crews will close the intersection of Northup Way and 108th Avenue Northeast to complete underground drainage and hydrant construction, and to remove the old signal poles and turn new signals on.

Details of the work:

- Date and time: 11 p.m. Friday, June 13 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 16
- Traffic and bus rider impacts: Crews will close the intersection of 108th Avenue
 Northeast and Northup Way and direct traffic to enter and exit SR 520 via a signed
 detour for the duration of the weekend. All ramps, roadways, and bus stops will reopen
 by 5 a.m. on Monday, June 9 and 16. Local access to businesses and homes will be
 maintained.

1. Weekend closure of SR 520 between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405 in Bellevue, June 20-23

Crews will close all lanes of SR 520 over the weekend of June 20-23 for many activities, including paving and restriping the eastbound lanes. Crews will place the 'leveling' lift of pavement on the eastbound lanes. Crews will also complete critical work in other parts of the SR 520 corridor.

Details of the work:

- Date and time: 11 p.m. Friday, June 20 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 23
- Traffic and bus rider impacts: Crews will close all lanes of SR 520 and bus stops between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405 in Bellevue for the duration of the weekend. All ramps, roadways, and bus stops will reopen by 5 a.m. on Monday, June 23.

1. Weekend closure of SR 520 between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405 in Bellevue, June 27-30

Crews will close all lanes of SR 520 over the weekend of June 27-30 for many activities, including paving and restriping the eastbound lanes. Crews will place the final lift of pavement on the eastbound lanes. Crews will also complete critical work in other parts of the SR 520 corridor.

Details of the work:

- Date and time: 11 p.m. Friday, June 27 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 30
- Traffic and bus rider impacts: Crews will close all lanes of SR 520 and bus stops between Montlake Boulevard in Seattle and I-405 in Bellevue for the duration of the weekend. All ramps, roadways, and bus stops will reopen by 5 a.m. on Monday, June 30.

1. 92nd Avenue Northeast roundabout construction update

The closure of Northeast Points Drive, originally scheduled to begin in April, has been postponed due to utility conflicts. Crews continue to work with the utility providers to resolve the issue. Once we have an updated schedule, we will send a notification update with the details. Despite the utility conflicts, crews have been able to work on other portions of the 92nd Avenue Northeast roundabout and transit stop to keep the project moving along. Thank you for your continued patience while we work through these unforeseen conflicts. Please stay tuned for more details.

What you can expect:

During these nighttime and weekend work activities, residents in the area may hear noise from trucks, back-up alarms and other equipment. Throughout this night work, crews will do their best to minimize noise by using ambient back-up alarms and walkie-talkies.

Please note that all of the work above is weather-dependent and could be delayed in the event of a major storm.
